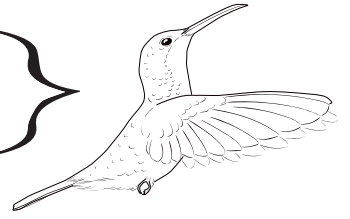
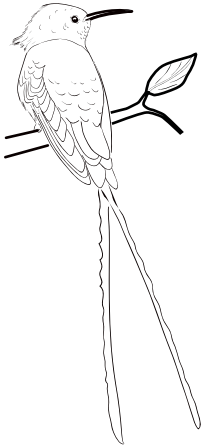


# Poetry in Motion

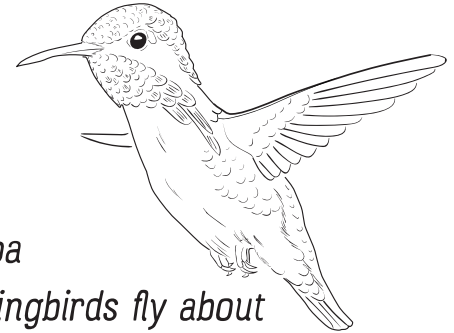
