About this Bird

Baltimore Orioles are very beautiful with their brilliant orange and black colours. On their breeding areas in North America, these birds weave amazing gourd-shaped, hanging nests from hair, human-made fibres such as string or wool, and plant fibres such as grasses, plant stems and Spanish moss. Baltimore Orioles eat insects (especially caterpillars), spiders, fruit and nectar. They migrate in flocks to southern Mexico, Central America and northern South America as well as northern Caribbean islands during the winter.
