About this Bird

The Bicknell's Thrush is a rare and shy bird that breeds in mountain forest areas in north-eastern US and south-eastern Canada. About 90% of the world's population migrates to the mountain forests of remote parts of the Dominican Republic, but a few spend the winter on other islands. Scientists have been studying it carefully because its numbers are declining, probably because a lot of its forest habitat is being cut down both in North America and the Caribbean. The Bicknell's Thrush searches for insects and spiders on the ground and also eats fruit. *Bird Size 17 cm, 6.75 in.*
