

# Northern Waterthrush

*Parkesia noveboracensis*



## About this Bird

The Northern Waterthrush breeds in Canada and the northern US and migrates to the Caribbean and South America in winter. It has a dark brown back, pale yellow underside with dark streaks, and a narrow pale-yellow line above the eye. In most of the Caribbean it can be seen near mangroves and other wetlands but in Trinidad it prefers mountain streams. As it walks on the forest floor or water's edge looking for insects, the Northern Waterthrush bobs its tail up and down. Listen for its loud *chink* call.
