
Find the warbler!

Match the silhouette to the right type of bird-there are some hints to help you



Warbler: small-bodied & thin bill for catching insects

Thrush: larger size, chunkier looking, often on the ground

Wren: bill longer than a warbler, stands less 'upright'

Gnatcatcher: Thinner looking & with a longer tail than a warbler
