1. LHWISET	Created on TheTeachersCorner.net Scramble Maker
I. LHWISET	High-pitched musical sound a bird makes.
2. STFERO	A large area covered by trees.
3. OEDLYM	A group of sounds that make up the music of a song.
4. SDGEARN	An area, usually near a house, where flowers, fruits and vegetables are grown.
5. RRAAOBLE	A word used to describe animals that live in trees and rarely come down to the ground.
6. UGROIREFV	This kind of animal only eats fruits.
7. SITFUR	The fleshy part of a plant that contains seeds and can be eaten.
8. ERISBER	A small round fruit.
9. PYPAAA	A fruit with orange flesh and a lot of small black seeds.
10. MAODEBRLI	A plant with short roots and spikey leaves, often seen growing on tree branches.
11. TNES	A structure or place an animal uses to lay eggs and raise young.
12. VINVIESA	A word used to describe an animal that is not native to a particular place. It competes with native animals for food and shelter.
