1. LHWISET	<b>WHISTLE</b>	High-pitched musical sound a bird makes.
2. STFERO	<b>FOREST</b>	A large area covered by trees.
3. OEDLYM	<b>MELODY</b>	A group of sounds that make up the music of a song.
4. SDGEARN	<b>GARDENS</b>	An area, usually near a house, where flowers, fruits and vegetables are grown.
5. RRAAOBLE	<b>ARBOREAL</b>	A word used to describe animals that live in trees and rarely come down to the ground.
6. UGROIREFV	<b>FRUGIVORE</b>	This kind of animal only eats fruits.
7. SITFUR	<b>FRUITS</b>	The fleshy part of a plant that contains seeds and can be eaten.
8. ERISBER	<b>BERRIES</b>	A small round fruit.
9. PYPAAA	<b>PAPAYA</b>	A fruit with orange flesh and a lot of small black seeds.
10. MAODEBRLI	<b>BROMELIAD</b>	A plant with short roots and spikey leaves, often seen growing on tree branches.
11. TNES	<b>NEST</b>	A structure or place an animal uses to lay eggs and raise young.
12. VINVIESA	<b>INVASIVE</b>	A word used to describe an animal that is not native to a particular place. It competes with native animals for food and shelter.
