1. LHWISET	WHISTLE	High-pitched musical sound a bird makes.
2. STFERO	FOREST	A large area covered by trees.
3. OEDLYM	MELODY	A group of sounds that make up the music of a song.
4. SDGEARN	GARDENS	An area, usually near a house, where flowers, fruits and vegetables are grown.
5. RRAAOBLE	ARBOREAL	A word used to describe animals that live in trees and rarely come down to the ground.
6. UGROIREFV	FRUGIVORE	This kind of animal only eats fruits.
7. SITFUR	FRUITS	The fleshy part of a plant that contains seeds and can be eaten.
8. ERISBER	BERRIES	A small round fruit.
9. PYPAAA	PAPAYA	A fruit with orange flesh and a lot of small black seeds.
10. MAODEBRLI	BROMELIAD	A plant with short roots and spikey leaves, often seen growing on tree branches.
11. TNES	NEST	A structure or place an animal uses to lay eggs and raise young.
12. VINVIESA	INVASIVE	A word used to describe an animal that is not native to a particular place. It competes with native animals for food and shelter.
