EICNEMD	ENDEMIC	word used to describe a plant or animal that lives only in a particular location
SUFURO	RUFOUS	reddish-brown colour used to describe the Brown Trembler
EYE SKAM	EYE MASK	mask that covers the upper part of the face with holes for the eyes
KEBA	BEAK	the pointed part of a bird's mouth
IEACTONRVSON	CONSERVATION	the protection and wise use of natural resources
FOAEGR	FORAGE	a verb; to look for food
ESTN	NEST	a structure or place that a bird uses for laying eggs and raising chicks
VENI	VINE	any plant with a long thin stem that grows along the ground or up a tree, wall, etc.
AUULGEDOEP	GUADELOUPE	one of the Caribbean islands where the Brown Trembler can be found. It is shaped like a butterfly.
ANISL	SNAIL	a mollusc with one pair of eyes, one pair of tentacles, a hard shell into which it can withdraw and uses its belly to crawl
ERMTELB	TREMBLE	the Brown Trembler does this when meeting other birds
TNIPTNLOAA	PLANTATION	a large area of land used to grow, usually one type of, crops
