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EICNEMD	word used to describe a plant or animal that lives only in a particular location
SUFURO	reddish-brown colour used to describe the Brown Trembler
EYE SKAM	mask that covers the upper part of the face with holes for the eyes
KEBA	the pointed part of a bird's mouth
IEACTONRVSON	the protection and wise use of natural resources
FOAEGR	a verb; to look for food
ESTN	a structure or place that a bird uses for laying eggs and raising chicks
VENI	any plant with a long thin stem that grows along the ground or up a tree, wall, etc.
AUULGEDOEP	one of the Caribbean islands where the Brown Trembler can be found. It is shaped like a butterfly.
ANISL	a mollusc with one pair of eyes, one pair of tentacles, a hard shell into which it can withdraw and uses its belly to crawl
ERMTELB	the Brown Trembler does this when meeting other birds
TNIPTNLOAA	a large area of land used to grow, usually one type of, crops
