
Puerto Rican Vireo Crossword





- Word used to describe an animal that is looking for food. (forage)
- any plant with a long thin stem that grows along the ground or up a tree, wall, etc. (vine)
- Colour of the Puerto Rican Vireo's throat and breast. (grey)
- **10.** An organism which deposits its eggs in the nest of another organism of the same or different species like the Shiny Cowbird. (two words with a space) (**nestparasite**)
- 13. An raised portion of the Earth's crust, that is higher than a hill and has steep sides. This is one area on Puerto Rico where you can find the Puerto Rican Vireo. (mountain)
- **15.** A place that an animal marks and defends from others, usually of the same species. (**territory**)
- To prevent something from being seen. (conceal)

1. A small tree that grows along the coast in saline or brackish water. (mangrove)

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- 3. When a female bird sits on its eggs to keep them warm and bring them to hatch. (incubate)
- This Caribbean island's name is Spanish for 'rich port.' (two words with a space) (puertorico)
- An animal that has three pairs of legs and one or two pairs of wings. (insect)
- 8. This bird is known to lay its eggs in the Puerto Rican Vireo's nest. (two names with a space). (shinycowbird)
- 9. Occurs when the place where a place an animal orplant lives is destroyed or extremely changed. For example, when the trees are cut down and the land is used for something else, like farming or buildinghomes or businesses. (two words with a space) (habitatloss)
- 11. A structure or place birds use to lay eggs and raise young. (nest)
- A plant or animal that is found in only one location. (endemic)
- **14.** An animal that attacks and eats another animal. (**predator**)
- **16.** A group of 3 or more of the same kind of birds. (**flock**)
