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| 1. RLWRBAE | a small insect-eating songbird that typically has a warbling song |
| 2. IGTMIROAN | seasonal movement of animals from one place to another |
| 3. WSPAM | an area of land that is permanently filled with water |
| 4. OETSRF | a large area primarily covered with trees and undergrowth |
| 5. PREAHPRGSSO | a medium to large sized plant-eating insect, well known for jumping or flying from plant to plant |
| 6. AEAPRLTICRL | the larva of a butterfly or moth which looks similar to a worm |
| 7. ESTN | structure or place made by a bird to lay its eggs, shelter and raise its young |
| 8. NUYORRDSET | common area where Prothonotary Warblers look for food, with young trees, short species of trees, shrubs, and soft-stemmed plants |
| 9. OTTRYIRER | an area of land that is defended by an animal against other animals of the same or different species |
| 10. OMYAMGNO | habit of having only one mate |
