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1. IENCEMD	a word used to describe a plant or animal that lives only in a particular location
2. TIAIH	one of two Caribbean country where the Black-capped Petrel is known to nest
3. STNE	a structure or place a bird uses for laying eggs and raising chicks
4. ADTNOBILI	local name for the Black-capped Petrel in Haiti, Dominican Republic and Dominica
5. LCGEPAI	relating to or living in the open sea
6. ISDQU	a soft-bodied mollusc which the Black-capped Petrel feeds on
7. NGEERDDENA	a species considered to be facing a very high risk of extinction in the wild
8. RADPTREO	an animal that preys on others
9. OGSEOOMN	a predator that feeds on Black-capped Petrel eggs
10. LOOLNPTUI	the addition of any harmful matter (liquid, gas or solid) to the environment
11. LRPETE	a type of seabird that spends most of its life away from land
12. ORVNTCAOSNEI	the protection and wise use of natural resources
