IEMCNED	ENDEMIC	word used to describe a plant or animal that lives only in a particular location
IIMUREANQT	MARTINIQUE	one of the two Caribbean islands where the Gray Trembler can be found
LTMEREB	TREMBLE	the drooping and fluttering wing movements made by the Gray Trembler
EEPIDTNCE	CENTIPEDE	a long, fast-moving arthropod with many legs and body segments
NLSAI	SNAIL	a mollusc with one pair of eyes, one pair of tentacles, a hard shell into which it can withdraw and uses its belly to crawl
KESYMAE	EYEMASK	a dark patch of feathers around the bird's eye
KAEB	BEAK	birds use this mostly for eating
AEFROG	FORAGE	a verb; to look for food
ONRATRFIES	RAINFOREST	a place with very tall trees, a variety of animals and gets a lot of rain throughout the year
ARNTCSOOVENI	CONSERVATION	the protection and wise use of natural resources
ENTS	NEST	a structure or place that a bird uses for laying eggs and raising chicks
IOARTNFESDTOE	DEFORESTATION	the clearing or cutting down of trees in a forest
