EEPIDTNCE	a long, fast-moving arthropod with many legs and body segments	_ _(
NLSAI	a mollusc with one pair of eyes, one pair of tentacles, a hard shell into which it can withdraw and uses its belly to crawl	
KESYMAE	a dark patch of feathers around the bird's eye	
KAEB	birds use this mostly for eating	
AEFROG	a verb; to look for food	
ONRATRFIES	a place with very tall trees, a variety of animals and gets a lot of rain throughout the year	
ARNTCSOOVENI	the protection and wise use of natural resources	_
ENTS	a structure or place that a bird uses for laying eggs and raising chicks	_
IOARTNFESDTOE	the clearing or cutting down of trees in a forest	_
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
