



SCAVENGER HUNT!

Yellow-throated Warblers favorite food is insects such as crunchy beetles, gooey caterpillars, and flies. They creep up branches and use their beaks to poke into crevices, pines cones, and clusters of pine needles for yummy insects.

We would like you, together with a few friends and a trusted adult, to go on a scavenger hunt!

For this scavenger hunt you will need to ask an adult to print the cards* below, on both sides of the paper.

*Each card measures 4.25 in X 5.5 in.

With the printed cards, head to your backyard or neighborhood park. Shuffle the printed cards, keeping the "Scavenger Hunt" side facing up, then turn over the top card.

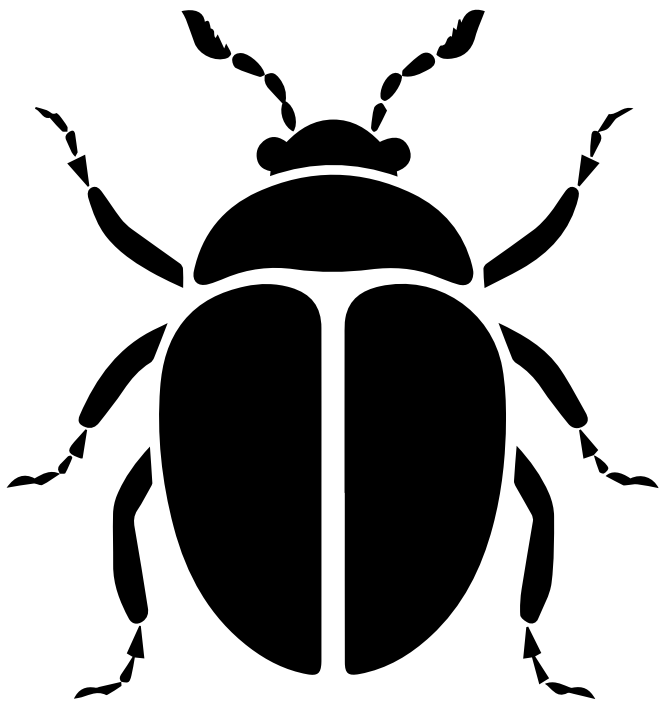
The first person to find the item on the card, gets to keep the card. Repeat with the remaining cards.

Remember you are ONLY looking. You DO NOT need to TOUCH or COLLECT anything.

Instead, if you have a camera or a phone you can take pictures of interesting things you see or ask the adult you're with to take pictures for you.

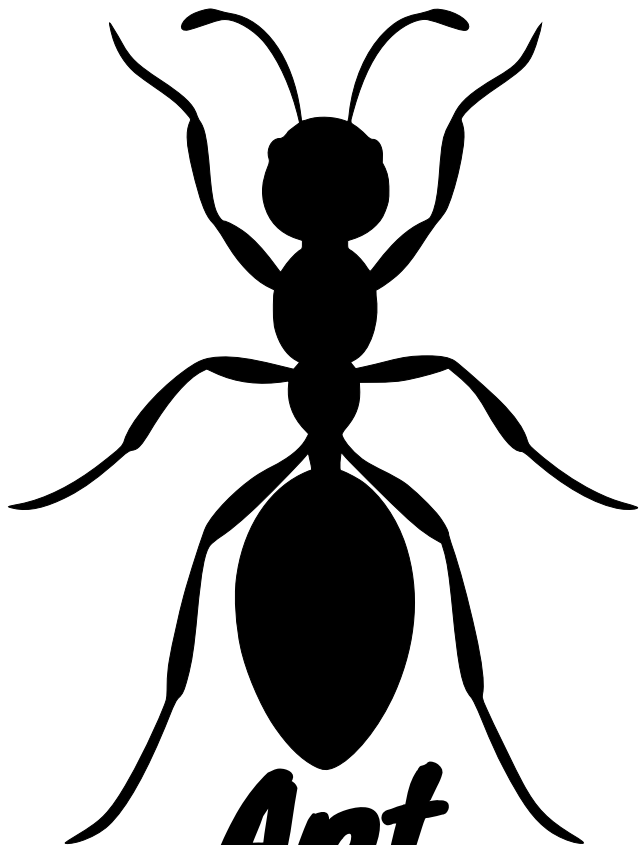

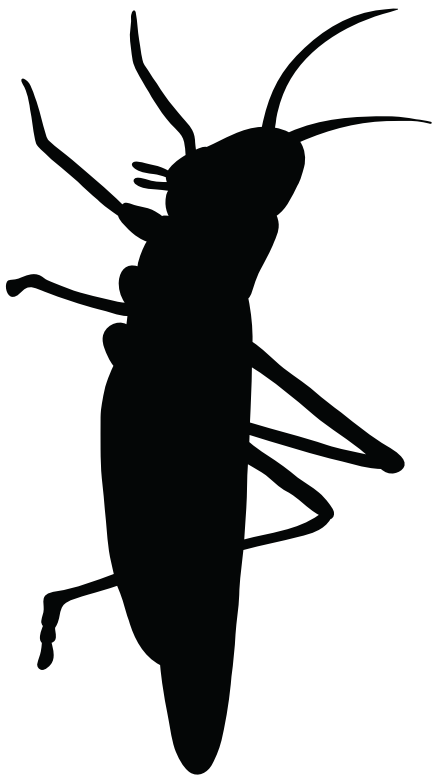




Ant

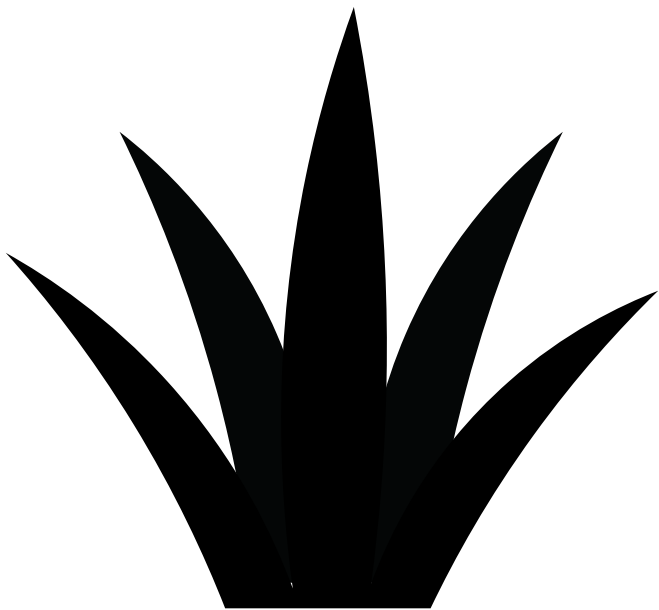




Grasshopper

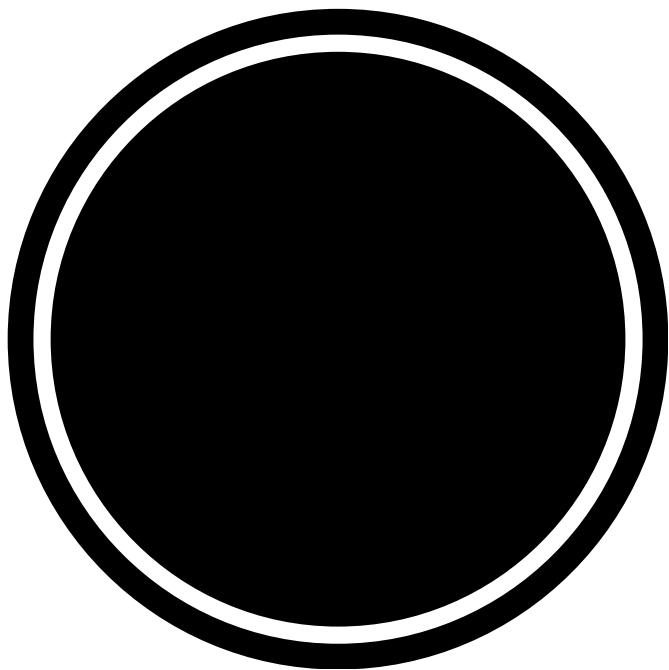




Spiky

Scavenger Hunt

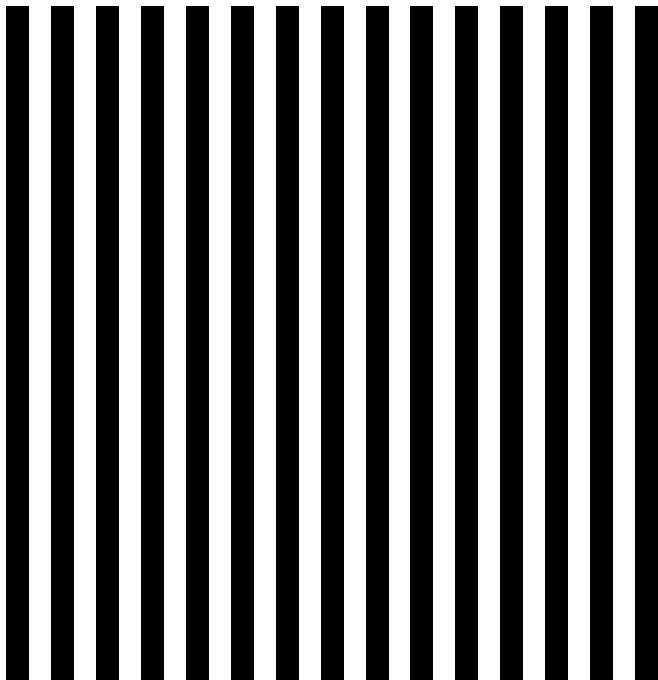




Round

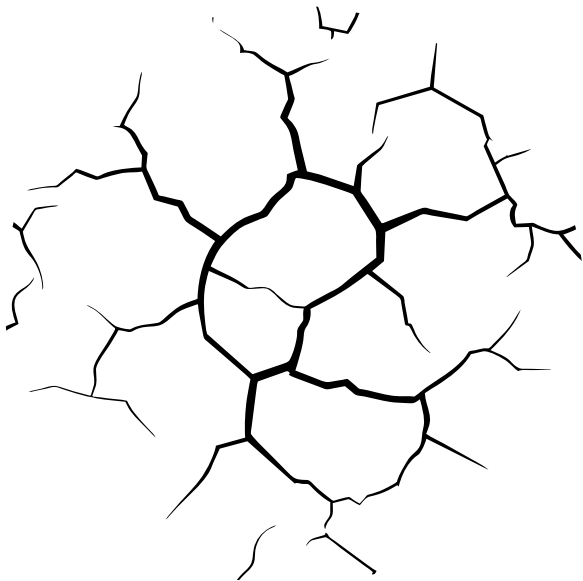




Stripey

Scavenger Hunt

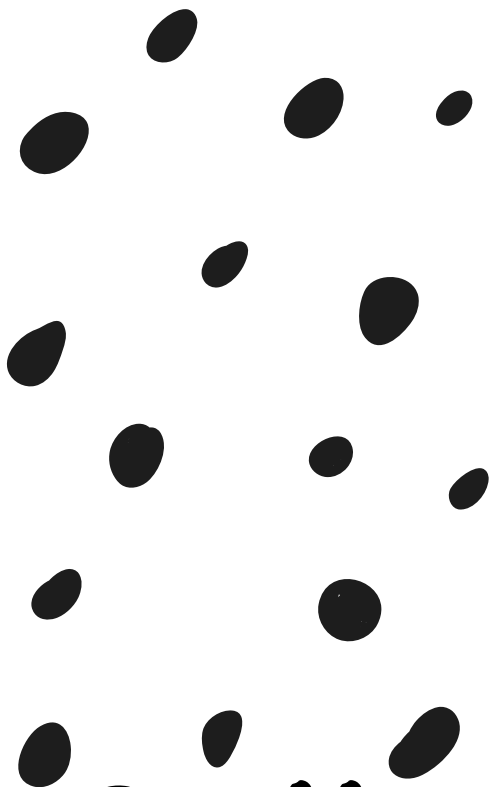




Dry

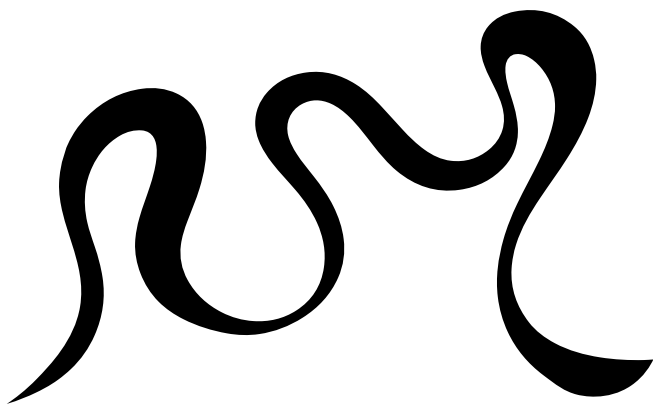

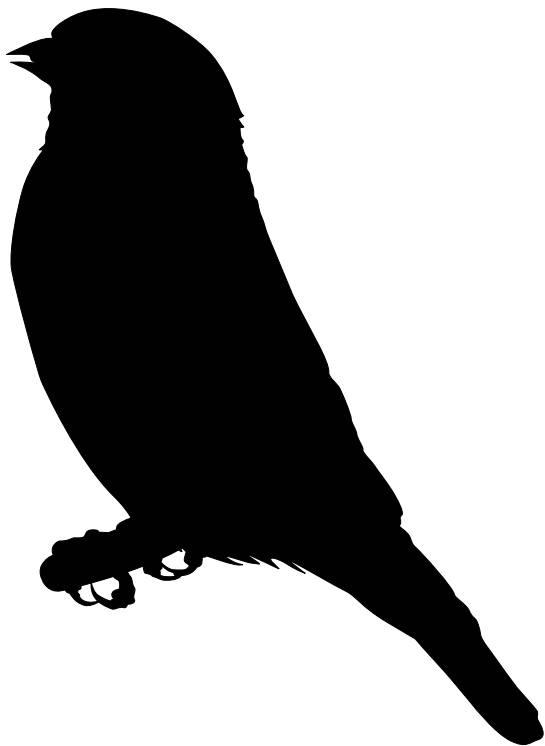




Curvy
